The Delegate will:

- Show respect for themselves and others
- Recognize and accept cultural differences graciously
- Be considerate of the family(s) with whom s/he stays
- Work cooperatively with the office staff and others involved in their project
- Work in collaboration with the office for any significant change in the project in advance of implementation
- Adopt appropriate behavior and dress which are consistent with the goals and purposes of BOSIA

I agree to the above rules of conduct. I understand that failure to abide by these standards may result in the severing of my relationship with BOSIA, and that I will be responsible for all costs incurred thereafter, including transportation back to the U.S.
